
#### PREPAREDNESS FOR FUTURE WATER RELATED DISASTERS

During the relief work earried out by JGVK during eyelong Aila (2009), it became apparent that Sundarbans is not well prepared for that kind of natural disasters. JGVK proposed UBU, Denmark for the ecoperation of the new project that included management of flood risks from eyelones and monsoon rainfalls. The project ideas have been developed at workshops in October 2011 and February 2013 with participation of women from several StIGs and CBOs from North and South 24 Parganas. It was decided to include two other natural water resource problems; an expansion of the work on arsenic mitigation to block level and investigations of the problem of the decline in groundwater tables in Basanti and other islands.


